WHAT?

CONFRONTO: an Italian word which means... to meet other young people engaged in the Salesian Youth Movement from all over Europe and the Middle East; to find time for personal prayer and reflection; to share our common Salesian Youth Spirituality in international working groups; to come back home with a renewed heart eager to witness Don Bosco's vision, passion and mission with and for the young.

THEME: Agents of Don Bosco's VISION, PASSION & MISSION

We want to go back to the roots of our Movement, before setting sail for the places where our **mission** calls us. Don Bosco's **vision** started with a dream sent by God. Let's go back where all this started, where Don Bosco's and Mother Mazzarello's **passion** burned for the love of God and the young.

In doing this, we put ourselves on the same path along which the whole Church is walking too. After two important Synods of the Bishops, Pope Francis recently gave the Church this great exhortation <u>Amoris Laetitia</u>, which is dedicated to love in the family. <u>Rector Major's Strenna 2017</u> to the Salesian Family is entitled "WE ARE A FAMILY! Every home, a school of Life and Love".

The places where Confronto 2017 will take place introduce us to the story of Don Bosco's family. They also talk us about why and how both Don Bosco and Madre Mazzarello recreated a family around many young people in need.

Within their own families, as well as in the service for the young and their families, SYM members can be agents of Don Bosco's vision, passion and mission today.

WHY?

Continuity. Last SYM Europe's Confronto was celebrated in 2009. It was the second meeting at this regional level, after the first European Confronto of 2004, which opened the way to the SYM Europe General Assemblies that we celebrate each year since then. Afterwards, SYM all over the world entered into the process of preparation of the Bicentenary of the birth of Don Bosco, which we celebrated in the global SYM Don Bosco 2015. In the meanwhile, we met again with our friends from all over the world in Madrid (2011) and then in Krakow (2016) for the WYD. We want to propose again the experience of a European gathering to confirm the good fruits of this path.

Strengthening national/provincial structures. In some European countries, SYM has already set an organizational structure with shared responsibilities among SDBs, FMAs and young people, who animate together a pastoral and educative proposal for the SYM groups of their Province/Country. In others countries this process has to be started yet. Confronto can be an opportunity to find the inspiration needed to start such a process, through the exchange of good practices.

Offering a quality proposal of Salesian Youth Spirituality. Confronto offers the opportunity to visit the places where Don Bosco and Mother Mazzarello lived and received God's call. Gathering young animators engaged in national/provincial SYM from all over Europe, Confronto wants to propose them a quality paradigm of daily practice of the Salesian Youth Spirituality, in an atmosphere of joy, prayer and fraternal sharing.

Looking forward. In 2018 all national/provincial SYM will be asked to reflect on the theme chosen by Pope Francis for the first time in history for the Assembly of the Synod of Bishops: "Youth, faith and vocational discernment". In 2019 WYD in Panama could be celebrated in January, making it very difficult for SYM Europe's members to join it. Next world SYM gathering could be scheduled in 2024 (for the Bicentenary of Don Bosco's dream) or in 2025 for the Holy Jubilee. Before that, we plan to propose a new SYM Europe Confronto, based on the evaluation of the 2017 edition, which we will share during next SYM Europe's GA (17-19 November 2017).
